stanley fish's *Surprised by Sin* first published in 1967 set a new standard for milton criticism and established its author as one of the world's preeminent milton scholars the lifelong engagement begun in that work culminates in this book the magnum opus of a formidable critic and the definitive statement on milton for our time how milton works from the inside out is the foremost concern of fish's book which explores the radical effect of milton's theological convictions on his poetry and prose for milton the value of a poem or of any other production derives from the inner worth of its author and not from any external measure of excellence or heroism milton's aesthetic says fish is an aesthetic of testimony every action whether verbal or physical is or should be the action of holding fast to a single saving commitment against the allure of plot narrative representation signs drama anything that might be construed as an illegitimate supplement to divine truth much of the energy of milton's writing according to fish comes from the effort to maintain his faith against these temptations temptations which in any other aesthetic would be seen as the very essence of poetic value encountering the great poet on his own terms engaging his equally distinguished admirers and detractors this book moves a 300 year debate about the significance of milton's verse to a new level

this authoritative edition was originally published in the acclaimed oxford authors series under the general editorship of frank kermode it brings together a unique combination of milton's poetry and prose all the english verse together with a generous selection from the major prosewritings to give the essence of his work and thinking milton's influence on english poetry and criticism has been incalculable and this edition covers the full range of his poetic and political output it includes *paradise lost paradise regained* and *samson agonistes* as well as major prose works such as *areopagitica* and *the tenure of kings and magistrates* as well as all the english and italian verse the volume includes most of the latin and greek verse in parallel translation spelling has been modernized and the poems are arranged in order of publication essential to an understanding of the progress of milton's career in relation to the political and religious upheavals of his time the extensive notes

the romantic legacy of paradise lost offers a new critical insight into the relationship between milton and the romantic poets shears devotes a chapter to each of the six major romantics contextualizing their misreadings of milton s paradise lost within a range of historical aesthetic and theoretical contexts shears argues that the romantic inclination towards fragmentation and a polysemous aesthetic leads to disrupted readings of paradise lost that obscure the theme or warp the grain of the poem

recent critical conversation has described john milton s major works as sites of uncertainty irreconcilability or even confusion as texts that actually reflect radical incoherence and openness these newer critical voices posit moreover that traditional critics must strain to find coherence and authorial control in milton s poetry richard durocher and margaret thickstun together with an esteemed group of milton scholars from a wide range of critical and theoretical backgrounds respond to this challenge while accepting the presence of uncertainty and welcoming the multiple perspectives that milton builds into his works this volume offers a variety of nuanced approaches to milton s texts as these eleven essays demonstrate milton s own acts of interpretation compel readers to reflect not only on the rival hermeneutics they find within his works but also on their own hermeneutic principles and choices an interpretive complexity that is integral to his poetry s enduring appeal thus each of the contributors takes up the problem of this interpretive dilemma in some way several explore milton s own engagement with the texts of scripture and the classics some examine the ways in which milton represents the process of interpretation in his narrative poems and still others are intrigued by the challenges that milton s works present for the reader s own interpretive skills milton s rival hermeneutics in responding directly to the incertitude critics of milton will be of interest to those on all sides of this debate and will certainly redirect the ongoing conversation

religion has always been an integral part of the literary tradition many canonical and non canonical texts engage extensively with religious ideas and the development of english literature as a professional discipline began with an explicit consideration of the relationship between religion and literature literature also plays an important role in religious writing as twentieth century work on narrative theology has acknowledged both the recent theological turn of literary theory and the renewed political significance of religious debate in contemporary western culture have generated further interest in this interdisciplinary area an introduction to religion and literature offers a lucid accessible and thoughtful introduction to the study of religion and literature while the focus is on christian theology and post 1800 british literature substantial reference is made to earlier writers texts from north america and mainland europe and other faith positions each chapter takes up a major theological idea and explores it through close readings of well known and influential literary texts

honorable mention 2018 mla prize for a first book against the defensive backdrop of countless apologetic justifications for the value of literature and the humanities futile pleasures reframes the current conversation by returning to the literary culture of early modern england a culture whose defensive posture toward literature rivals and shapes our own during the renaissance poets justified the value of their work on the basis of the notion that the purpose of poetry is to please and instruct that it must be both delightful and useful at the same time many of these writers faced the possibility that the pleasures of literature may be in conflict with the demand to be useful and valuable analyzing the rhetoric of pleasure and the pleasure of rhetoric in texts by william shakespeare roger ascham thomas nashe edmund spenser and john milton mceleney explores the ambivalence these writers display toward literature s potential for useless frivolous vanity tracing that ambivalence forward to the modern era this book also shows how contemporary critics have recapitulated renaissance humanist ideals about aesthetic value against a longstanding tradition that defensively advocates for the redemptive utility of literature futile pleasures both theorizes and performs the queer pleasures of futility without ever losing sight of the costs of those pleasures mceleney argues that playing with futility may be one way of moving beyond the impasses that modern humanists like their early modern counterparts have always faced

one particularly challenging aspect of the hebrew bible is its treatment of various forms of voluntary death suicide suicide attack martyrdom and self sacrifice how can people of faith make sense of the ways biblical literature at times valorizes these sensitive and painful topics willingness to die and the gift of life surveys a

diverse selection of hebrew bible narratives that feature characters who express a willingness to die including mooses judah samson esther job daniel and the suffering servant of isaiah 53 the challenging truth uncovered is that the hebrew bible while taking seriously the darker aspects of voluntary death nevertheless time and again valorizes the willingness to die particularly when it is for the sake of the group or in faithful commitment to god many biblical authors go so far as to suggest that death willingly embraced can unlock immense power endowing the willing with the charism necessary to lead opening the possibility of salvation and even paving the way for resurrection into a new more glorious life paul k k cho s unflinching analysis raises and wrestles with provocative questions about religious extremism violent terrorism and suicidal ideation all of which carry significant implications for the biblically grounded life of faith today cho carefully situates the surveyed texts in their original cultural context discussing relevant topics such the shame and honor culture of ancient israel and the importance attached to the group over the individual closing with an epilogue that reflects on the surprising issue of whether biblical authors considered god to be capable of dying or being willing to die cho s fascinating study showcases the multifaceted relationship between death and life in the hebrew bible
